Negotiating obstacles on foot, bikes & scooters Using equipment safely indoors and outdoors Moving on different parts of our body, choosing ways to move across equipment, eq skip, hop, crawl Observing our body before and after activity Throwing and catching Developing core strength and important muscles for writina. Developing a comfortable grip when holding pencils and forming letters correctly

Maths (Number / Shape, Space & Measure) Numeral recognition: 1-10 ordering, guantifying and counting reliably using 1-1 correspondence, counting in rote to 10 Subitising amounts to 3 and then to 5 Recording numerals and amounts Naming 2D and 3D shapes and talking about properties Comparative language of size, height, length, capacity Investigating pattern - regular and abstract Real world problem solving Number rhymes and songs Compare quantities using 'more than' 'fewer than'

## Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

Using a range of tools, techniques and materials (glue, scissors, brushes, pens and pencils) modelling, drawing, making, sticking,

Listening to and moving to various kinds of music, singing songs and rhymes/ making and playing instruments /matching pitch/singing melodic shape Role Play stories and real life experiencing Developing complex stories using small world equipment,
